AM DANG-MITCHELL came to the Prairies by way of Paris (she was born there while her mother was studying at the Sorbonne), and it shows. Scroll through her Instagram feed and you'll see counties examples of the same effortlessly chic style that all French women seem to have built into their DNA. What sets Nam apart, though, is her unique ability to recreate that sumptuous glamour in interior designs that still read as approachable and livable.

Nam studied fine arts as a photography major at the University of Calgary but she wasn't sure what career path to take after graduating, "I loved magazines: I'd had a complete obsession with them since I was a teen " she says "But there weren't many in Calgary, so I went to the library to pore over old issues of Communication Arts - and that's how I fell in love with graphic design." She made some layout mock-ups using her own photography and soon landed a job as a designer at an ad agency, eventually becoming its youngest VP of design.

After leaving the agency to co-found McKinley Dang Burkart, an interior design and architecture firm. Nam got her wish to work in magazines, serving as creative director of Avenue in 2001 as a five-month project. Then, in 2015, she founded her eponymous interior design firm; it wasn't long before the business was flourishing. Nam's passion for interior design is undenjable. "I love

the aspirational aspect of building a dream home: it feeds into the romance of an ideal life." she says "I think a home can inspire someone to be the best version of themself"

House & Home took note of Nam's talent in 2011 and since then, she's become a staple on our magazine's pages. Last year. Nam won H&H's People's Choice Award for Home of the Year after wowing readers with a characterpacked new-build in Calgary. Nam's kitchens are especially outstanding - she says they reflect a homeowner's essence and often feature details such as custom facetted islands and nickel-trimmed vent hoods "I can't design a house until I figure out what the kitchen looks like." she says. "It informs the rest of the house. I also get insights from the way a homeowner dresses: are they casual or more formal?"

To be clear, in a NDMdesigned home, "casual" may read "effortless," but it's always as polished and photogenic as the designer herself. Whether

she's at an elephant orphanage in Kenya or floating in a Mexican cenote (an avid traveller. Nam's Insta account boasts more than 34 000 followers), her life in pictures is the model of high style. In fact, travel with her husband, developer James
